Dear Parent and Carer,

I wrote to you before the Whitsun half term break to inform you that, following the completion of assessments in school, teachers are now completing the *Centre Determined Grades* (CDG) process. This will be concluded on Friday 18th June; we will therefore be in a position to release provisional CDGs for qualifications at GCSE, AS and A level on **Monday 21st June**.

We will be providing each student with a CDG for each qualification. Every grade will be supported by a *Decision Making Record* (DMR) which contains a range of information, including the rationale for decisions made. We will also provide information on the appeals process which follows on directly after the release of this information.

We have made the following arrangements for the collection of CDGs and DMRs:

Year 10 (Mathematics)

Grades will be released to students at an appropriate time within the school day.

Year 11

Year 11 students are invited to collect their CDGs (and supporting documents) from the **Sports Hall** between 3.15 p.m. and 4.15 p.m. Students should enter from the fire doors adjacent to the staff car park. Senior staff will guide students to the relevant collection station in the Sports Hall and will be available to support with any urgent queries.

Year 12

Year 12 students are invited to collect their CDGs (and supporting documents) from the **Oriel** at 10.00 a.m. Senior staff will be available to support students with any urgent queries.

Year 13

Year 13 students are invited to collect their CDGs (and supporting documents) from **Lle Dysgu** at 8.30 a.m. Senior staff will be available to support students with any urgent queries.

Please inform the school via email admin.bryntirioncomp@bridgend.gov.uk by **Friday 18th June** if you are unable to collect grades at the allotted time, and we will make alternative arrangements for collection.
