

Information for Students intending to return to Year 12

- The term will start on Tuesday, September 5th at 8.40 am. **However, there will be an induction for all Year 12 students on Monday 4th September.** Students are asked to gather in the Senior Hall at 11.00am where there will be a meeting with Mr Beard. The programme for the day will be outlined during this session and it is vital that students attend. There is no need for students to wear uniform for the induction day.
- On commencing their studies on Tuesday students will be expected in full school uniform namely black shoes, black trousers/skirt, white shirt and a Bryntirion Sixth Form jumper. No cardigans, 'skinny' jeans or hoodies are acceptable. Initially, students are asked to wear the tie they used in Year 11. A Sixth Form tie will be issued by the school as soon as possible.
- The Induction Programme on the 4th September will aim to ensure that every student is placed in their best interest. A discussion with a Sixth Form Tutor will focus on their preferred subjects and the number of subjects that is best for them.
- **Students returning to school for the induction day on the 4th September need to be aware that this does not guarantee their being able to continue in the sixth form or with their preferred courses. Their GCSE achievement will be closely considered to ensure that their choice of course is appropriate for them.**
- It is very important that we understand which students intend to study a course at another institution. These students will be issued with a separate pack which includes a parental consent sheet that needs to be signed and returned on Tuesday, September 5th.
- Students who wish to study a subject in a collaborative arrangement at another institution need to make this known to Mr Beard on the induction day (Monday 4th September).
