ACTIVITIES

Pupils are required to speak to each other in Welsh.

They will have the opportunity to visit the Urdd Camps at Llangrannog and Glan Llyn where they will experience an all Welsh community. In addition participation at Eisteddfodau is encouraged.

Pupils have the opportunity to use their IT skills during lessons. They have access to interactive white-boards, which improves key skills and enhances teaching and learning.

Learning will also be reinforced through interactive Welsh language apps and pupils will also view programmes on S4C.



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YEAR 7

A detailed study of the present tense with a focus on all three skills, reading, writing and oracy. This module will develop vocabulary, grammar and enhance literacy skills.

YEAR 8

A detailed study of the past tense with a focus on reading, writing and oracy. This module will develop the past tense through a variety of topics.

YEAR 9

A detailed study of the future tense. Pupils will commence the GCSE course and start preparing for the Unit 1 exam.

ASSESSMENT

Formal assessments are held three times a year.
