PSE provides an opportunity for students to explore and discover a range of issues relating to their own personal development and their relationship to others and the world around them. PSE is delivered as a timetabled lesson, with all students in years 7, 8 and 9 taking part in one lesson per fortnight, and as part of the Welsh Baccalaureate in Years 10 and 11. Students have the opportunity to take part in a diverse range of learning activities, as well as Theatre in Education performances and presentations by visiting speakers.

The Curriculum

Students follow a broad and relevant curriculum, which creates opportunity for self-reflection and personal growth: themes include sex and relationship education, financial literacy, social media safety and ethics, global citizenship and moral issues.
