Why Study Welsh?

There is no doubt that the ability to speak Welsh is an increasingly sought after asset. As a department, we will provide both an educational and an enjoyable experience and have a 100% pass rate at AS and A2.

You will follow a recognised academic subject and have many opportunities for personal development. Pupils are encouraged to take part in the Eisteddfod and Cymanfa Ganu. The A level is enriched by opportunities to attend residential courses to Llangrannog and Glan-Ilyn. Pupils will develop their understanding of culture, the arts and media in Wales by visiting the Wales Millennium Centre, Principality Stadium and theatres. They will see how modern Wales is changing and developing its role in Europe when attending the Welsh Assembly. Pupils have the opportunity to embrace Welsh culture, develop their language skills and have fun!

What will I study?

AS Level

- A study of the film Patagonia with oral group work
- Pupils will complete a coursework project on a topic of their choice. The topic can be of local or national interest, contemporary or traditional
- The use of language and poetry



A Level

- Pupils will develop their proficiency in spoken Welsh in a group discussion about the theatre and media in Wales
- Pupils will extend their use of written Welsh, developing accuracy giving them linguistic skills for further academic study or the workplace
- Aspects of Welsh literature and short stories will provide an opportunity to develop an overview of the Welsh language and the dynamics of change in Wales
