Dear Parent/Guardian

I write to inform you that there will be a change to the structure of the school day when pupils return in September (see table below). School will finish this term on Wednesday, 20th July 2016 at 3.15pm. **Next term will start for all pupils (except Year 12) on Monday, 5th September 2016. The 1st and 2nd of September will be INSET days.**

The induction programme is designed to ensure that each student receives the best possible guidance in making informed choices on their future careers. A discussion with a Sixth Form Tutor will focus on their preferred subjects and the number of subjects that is best for them. Further information will be supplied with the GCSE results in August.

Please be aware that school rules and the uniform code will continue to be applied in September. I would like to draw your attention in particular to the following areas:

Uniform

- Black full-length trousers or green skirt (girls), white shirt, plain black V-necked school jumper bearing the school logo, school tie, black shoes and socks.
- **No denim or 'skinny' leg trousers are permitted. Trainers must not be worn.**
- A dark coloured coat may be worn. **Hooded tops cannot be worn in place of a coat.**

School Rules

- The only jewellery allowed is a plain stud in each ear. **No facial jewellery or any form of body jewellery** is allowed. Make-up is not to be used. **Hair should be a sensible length, style and colour and must not impede vision.** Hair lacquer, gel and chemicals which colour the hair should not be used by pupils.
