Bryntirion is a co-educational 11-18 school. The pupil admission number has **increased to 221 per year group**, a result of the completion of a new build, a block containing 4 additional classrooms which opened in September 2025.

An opportunity to meet with staff, visit the various departments and to get to know the school prior to completing the Secondary School Admission Application via the Local Authority.

There will be a welcome and introduction meeting in the Senior Hall with Mr Mead, Headteacher, at 4.00pm, repeated at 5.00pm.

Bryntirion is a popular, successful and happy school where all young people have outstanding opportunities and experiences. We value everyone equally, and make it our mission to develop the skills and talents that all pupils undoubtedly have.

An application for a Year 7 place must be submitted by a parent/ carer via the Local Education Authority. There is no automatic admission to any secondary school, regardless of the primary or junior school that a child currently attends.

The Local Education Authority (LEA) will open the online secondary school application site for pupils transferring from junior/primary school (Year 6) to secondary school (Year 7) in September 2027 as follows:

Notification to applications of offer or refusal of places (the 'offer date')	Monday, 1 March 2027
Parents to notify the local authority of acceptance or refusal of places offered	Monday, 15 March 2027
Closing date for parents/carers to submit an appeal	4pm - Monday, 5 April 2027
