

The start of the journey

Pupil organisation

On the first day in school (Tuesday 7th September 2021) pupils should make their way to the Sports Hall by 8.40am where they will be put into their form and teaching classes. There will be staff outside in the school grounds to direct them. Subsequently they will begin each day in their mixed ability **form class** with their **form teacher** who is responsible (along with the Head of Year and Assistant Head of Year) for their pastoral well-being.





There are also opportunities for parents to upskill their own maths and English skills through our partners in Bridgend College. Classes will initially be virtual but may once more be in school when guidelines allow.




MATHS
